

2023 Produce Pinning Map- Rules

The Produce Pinning Map is available to post produce fields with appropriate distance requirements in Imperial County. Participation is voluntary, and IVVGA/ICFB has no legal authority over posted locations. The purpose of the map is for all growers and sheep herders to review the locations before "sheeping" their field. This includes the transportation of sheep to and from fields.

Only produce growers are asked to pin their fields. All pinning will be completed by the respective grower, and managed on a frequent basis by IVVGA/ICFB staff. Fields will *not* be pinned by staff.

The map will be hosted on a Google Map platform. A step-by-step guide to accessing/pinning the map will be available to all growers, as well as on <u>www.ivvga.com/resources</u>. Please note the distance required by shipper, IID canal and gate number, contact information, and plant/estimated harvest date.

By pinning a field on the Produce Pinning Map, the grower agrees to:

- Update the map on a frequent basis
- Pin accurate data to the best of their knowledge
- Work with fellow growers/sheep herders to come to an amicable solution
 - $\circ \quad \text{i.e provide alternate fields} \quad$
